

**ORDINANCE NO. 4 OF 2008  
OF THE BOROUGH OF SUMMIT HILL**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2-1971 PROVIDING  
FOR THE ERECTION OF STOP SIGNS AND REGULATING PARKING ON  
THE STREETS OF THE BOROUGH OF SUMMIT HILL AND  
PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR ANY VIOLATION THEREOF.**

**BE IT Enacted and Ordained by the Council of the Borough of Summit Hill,  
Carbon County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of  
the same as follows:**

**ARTICLE I.** Article No. 3 of Ordinance No. 2, 1971, is **AMENDED** to include the following:

There shall be erected at the following intersections a Stop Sign as provided by the Uniform Regulations of the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

1. At the intersection of Carbon Avenue and Linden Street stopping traffic traveling West on Carbon Avenue as traffic approaches and intersects with Linden Street.
2. At the intersection of Carbon Avenue and Poplar Street stopping traffic traveling East on Carbon Avenue as traffic approaches and intersects with Poplar Street; and


**ARTICLE II.** All other provisions of Ordinance No. 2-1971 and any other amendments thereto remain in full force and effect.

**ARTICLE III.** Any Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


**ARTICLE IV.** The effective date of this Ordinance shall be upon its enactment.
