

**Summit Hill Borough Council**  
**December 2, 2010, 7:00 p.m., Borough Hall**

The special meeting of the Summit Hill Borough to tentatively adopt the 2011 budget was held at the above date and time with President Joe Weber presiding.

**Roll Call** – President Joe Weber, Vice President John O’Gurek, Mike Alabovitz, Ken Boyd, Harry Miller, Bill Chapman, Michael Kokinda were in attendance. Solicitor Joseph Matika and Mayor Paul McArdle were absent.

**Floor-** Nothing at this time

**Budget** – President Joseph Weber said the first order of business is to tentatively adopt and advertise the 2011 budget. The total income being \$1,419,403.40 total expenses being \$1,419,403.40 broken down as follows: total millage is 15.1 which would be broken down to 13.1 mills to general fund, ½ a mill for fire and 1.5 mills for streets and lighting. Jack Reiber, 311 South Pine Street, asked if Council can cut from anywhere else in the budget to not have to raise the taxes. Joe Weber explained that they have gone over the budget many times and they have tried cutting from everywhere they could to not have to raise taxes. They even discussed possible layoffs in the police department as well as the borough workforce. Joe stressed that even though they are not going to be laying off at this time, this is still an option. **Motion was made by Mike Kokinda and second by Bill Chapman to tentatively adopt the 2011 budget with a 1.5 mill increase with income and expenses in the amount of \$1,419,403.40.** The motion was opened to the floor for comment; none made. Motion carried unanimously by Council.

**Motion was made by Bill Chapman and second by Mike Kokinda to adjourn at 7:07 p.m. until the next regular scheduled meeting of the Summit Hill Borough on December 13, 2010.** The motion was opened to the floor for comment, none made. Motion carried unanimously by Council.
